

Volunteer Worksheet

(check box or boxes below)

INSIDE the Clubhouse:

- Sweep the floors
- Mop the floors
- Clean the bathrooms
- Work in the Office for 1 hour
- Work in the Office for 2 hours

OUTSIDE the Clubhouse:

Pistol Range:

- Clean up the shooting area

5-Stand/TRAP:

- Clean up the shooting area

Grounds:

- Mow the grass
- Weed
- Weed-eat the grounds
- Wad clean-up
- Spray for weeds
- Spray for gorse

Inside:

Before members arrive or after members have left, put the chairs on the tables and sweep and/or mop the floor. The bathrooms should be cleaned weekly and deep cleaned monthly.

Working in the Office means taking money from members, recording money received.

Outside:

Clean up of the shooting areas includes trash pickup as well as any brass or wads laying around.

There is a riding mower for volunteers to use. Mowing is mainly needed during the sunny/dry months and not so much during winter.

Weeding and spraying is needed year round but especially in the sunny months.

Weed-eating is needed year round but especially in the sunny months.

Wad clean-up has been handled on a once a year basis but it might be better if this is done twice a year utilizing a blower and/or rakes to corral all the used wads. And this might be a better option for 5-stand/Trap users than pistol range shooters.
