

## **Membership Dues and Assessments Policy**

In December the Board of Directors (BOD) at any regular or special meeting, shall set the annual individual and family membership dues for the next fiscal year.

The new membership dues will become effective immediately and take effect January 1<sup>st</sup> of the new year. Until such time as the BOD has set dues for the new year, there shall be NO early payment for the next year's membership dues in the amount of past or the current amounts.

Individual and family membership renewal dues shall become due and payable on January first (1<sup>st</sup>) of each year. (After the first membership year all membership renewal dues are due on January first (1<sup>st</sup>) of each year.)

All Club forms are available on-line. For those unable to meet the January target, you can download the forms, complete and sign and mail, along with your check to the post office address listed above. If you have provided an email address, you will receive confirmation your membership has been renewed.

The termination of a membership does not relieve the membership from any obligations the membership may have to the Club as a result of financial or other obligations incurred or commitments made prior to termination. Any membership that has been terminated shall forfeit all rights granted to memberships, as defined in Article II, Section 3 of "*The Bandon Gun Club, inc. Bylaws*". Any membership that has been terminated may apply at any time thereafter for a renewed membership by making their payment of the individual or family membership renewal dues.

Fees, as shall be set by the Board of Directors, shall be charged for participation in shooting during the regular posted Club hours and during special Club shooting events; for purchases of products for sale; and for special Club functions. The amounts of the fees shall be posted at the Club's office.

Special assessments shall be determined by a quorum vote of the Board of Directors at any regular or special meeting of the Board of Directors. Any special assessments shall be reported to memberships in good standing no less than thirty (30) days before the special assessments are due and payable, in the same manner as written notices, as defined in Article IX, of "*The Bandon Gun Club, Inc. Bylaws*".
